AUTHORISATION REGARDING COVID-19 VACCINATIONS FOREIGN GOVERNMENTS

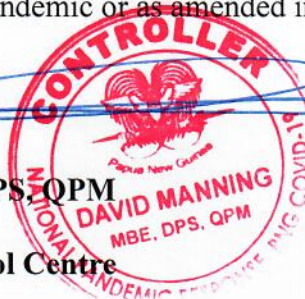
I, David Manning, Commissioner of Police and National Pandemic Controller, by virtue of sections 9(1)(a), 9(1)(r), 39, and 47 of the *National Pandemic Act 2020*, and all other enabling powers, hereby issue the follow authorization.

Foreign Governments with diplomatic missions in Papua New Guinea may provide COVID-19 vaccinations, subject to the following conditions:

1. Vaccinations are done on the grounds of the Foreign Government's diplomatic mission.
2. Vaccinations are provided by medical personal registered in PNG or by the relevant authority in the relevant foreign government's country.
3. Vaccinations are only provided to citizens or permanent residents of the foreign government's country.
4. Vaccinations used must have received an emergency use exemption in Papua New Guinea from the Minister of Health & HIV/AIDS per section 4 of the *Medicines and Cosmetics Act 1999*.

This Direction comes into effect on Wednesday, 5 May 2021, and continues in force during the period of the declaration of a pandemic or as amended in writing by The Controller.
