DIRECTION FOR AIR SERVICE PROVIDERS

1, David Manning, Commissioner of Police and State of Emergency Controller, by virtue of the National Pandemic Act 2020, and all other enabling powers, hereby, provide the following exemption to the Measures and Direction issued yesterday to all Air Service Providers.

All Air Service Providers are provided a two-week exemption, limited to persons who had on or before the 10th of March 2021 booked a domestic airline ticket, prior to the requirement that a person must have a valid reason for travelling, per Measure 3.

For clarity, all passengers who book after the 10th of March 2021 must have a valid reason for travel in compliance with the Measures and the Direction. For passengers who have a return flight booked on or before 10th March 2021, a grace period to return to their originating port of departure is in place until the 25th of March 2021.

This Exemption comes into immediate effect, and continues in force until the 25th of March 2021.
