

Important reminders to the staff and visitors of the National Control Center

- 1** If you are sick, DO NOT come to the National Control Center (NCC). Stay home and do not socialize.



- 2** If you have fever, cough, runny nose or difficulty breathing, call the COVID-19 Hotline 1-800200. If you are told to self-isolate, you must do so immediately.



- 3** Follow the prevention measures at the NCC. Have your temperature recorded and sanitize your hands. If you do not pass the temperature check, you will be denied entry to the NCC.



- 4** Greet each other with a smile, a nod or a simple hello – no handshakes, fist or elbow bumps!



- 5** Maintain at least one metre distance between you, your colleagues and others. Wear a face mask if physical distancing is not possible.



- 6** In meetings and consultations, ensure you are seated at least one metre from each other.



- 7** Sneeze or cough into your elbow, or use a tissue and dispose into bin immediately.



- 8** Wash your hands frequently or use an alcohol-based sanitizer or hand rub.



- 9** Clean and disinfect your workplace and personal items regularly, including your phone and laptop.



- 10** Stay vigilant. Watch out for symptoms in yourself and colleagues.



As a COVID-19 frontliner, set an example and practice what we preach.

It is also your responsibility to remind others to do the same.
