STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDER No.6
OFFICE OF THE CONTROLLER

IMPOUNDING OF AIRCRAFT, VEHICLES & VESSELS

I, Commissioner David Manning, Emergency Controller, by virtue of the *Emergency (General Provisions) (COVID 19) Act 2020 (Act)*, hereby issue the following emergency orders for immediate implementation:

1. All aircraft, vehicles and vessels that are found or suspected to be transporting persons in breach of travel restrictions as Ordered by the Emergency Controller shall be impounded by Authorised Officer(s) and impounded for the period of National Emergency.
2. All aircraft, vehicles and vessels that are confiscated and impounded as Ordered by the Emergency Controller, as soon as practicable be returned to the owner at the end of the National Emergency.
3. If, in the event the owner of the aircraft, vehicle and vessels cannot be located, the Government may as directed by the Emergency Controller, have the aircraft, vehicles and vessels auctioned off.
4. Any revenue generated from sales under paragraph 3, must be deposited into Government of Papua New Guinea's Consolidated Revenue Account.
5. Any Authorised Officer(s) appointed by the Emergency Controller pursuant to the Regulation, shall carry out and enforce the Emergency Orders accordingly.
6. This Order comes into effect on 2 June 2020 and shall apply for the duration of the National Emergency.
